Mayor Trapani,

This letter expresses the Walter Anderson Museum of An's desire to officially partner with the City of Waveland on a 2023 program, the Waveland Public Art Enterprise. This program is funded through private dollars, including support from the National Recreation Foundation and Mississippi Power. The Waveland Public Enterprise builds upon a successful model recently enacted in Pascagoula, which was a partnership between the Museum, the City of Pascagoula, the Pascagoula-Gautier School District's College and Career Technical Institute (CCTI), and others.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Waveland Public Art Enterprise leverages art making and the environment to provide increased outdoor education in public schools, as well as to address the challenges of brain drain and STEM workforce development. Over the course of the program in 2023, approximately 25 high school students from Hancock County will work with professional artists to design, fabricate, and install a large-scale steel sculpture in Waveland, Mississippi. Students will find inspiration through excursions into coastal environments, conduct community-engaged design work to solicit public input, collaborate with professional artists to engineer the steel structure, and hone skills of welding and fabrication to bring the artwork to life. Upon completion, the sculpture's will be gifted to the City of Waveland. Installed at a location selected in partnership with the City, the artwork is intended to honor local history and civic pride, serve as a landmark to direct visitors to the city's downtown infrastructure and amenities, and provide a vehicle for STEM skill acquisition and student discovery that supports homegrown workforce development and overall student health in Coastal Mississippi.

The Museum is not requesting any additional cash support, only a partnership to help facilitate site selection and installation logistics for the large-scale sculpture that will be gifted to the City.

The structure will be fifteen (15) feet from the rear property line and ten (10) feet from the side property line which does not require any variances as stated in Zoning Ord. #349 section 716.2.

Mr. Mortenson was not able to attend the meeting. After brief discussion between the Commission, Chairman Frater called for anyone from the audience to come forward for comment. Walter Perez, representing the property owned by the Life Estate of Kathleen Perez on Art St, came forward for clarification on the request. After discussions with the Commission, Mr. Perez stated that he and his family do not have any objections to the Conditional Use request.

After all discussions, Chairman Frater called for a motion. Commissioner Whitney made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Touart to accept the Conditional Use Request.

After a vote of yes by Commissioners Cooper, Whitney, and Touart with Commissioner Poindexter recusing himself, Chairman Frater declared the motion passed in accordance with section 906.3 of the Zoning Ordinance.

3. The City of Waveland Building & Zoning Department is making a request for the consideration of revising the current Zoning Ordinance #349. The revision will be to change the side-yard setbacks for non-conforming lots in Section 713.3, Side Yard, as stated in Ordinance #349. The revision will be in section 713.3C and the new wording will state "For a lot of record, which qualifies pursuant to Section 402.3 as legally non-conforming and which measures sixty (60) feet or less in width, the Zoning Official is authorized to grant a variance of side yard minimum footage to allow a side yard setback of ten (10) feet. Said action may be taken without notice to or action by the Planning and Zoning Commission or the Board of Mayor and Aldermen."

Jeanne Conrad, Zoning Official for the City of Waveland, came forward to explain the Building & Zoning Department request. (See audio for discussions.)

Minutes Regular Meeting of The Board of Mayor & Aldermen Wednesday, February 22, 2023 6:30 p.m.

The Board Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Waveland, Mississippi, met in regular session at the Waveland City Hall Boardroom, 301 Coleman Avenue, Waveland, Mississippi, on February 22, 2023 at 6:30 p.m. to take action on the following matters of City business.

ROLL CALL

Mayor Trapani noted for the record the presence of Aldermen Gamble, Richardson, Lafontaine, and Clark along with City Clerk Lisa Planchard. Absent from the meeting was City Attorney Ronnie Artigues.

MAYOR'S COMMENTS

Mayor Trapani briefly spoke about the Citywide Boil Water notice and that the City has been under a Citywide Boil Water Notice for over one day. He said hopefully that will be taken down tomorrow evening. He told the citizens that there were extremely high water pressures throughout the city causing water lines to burst. The city had to adjust the 4 wells by turning some of them off. Around 8 o'clock last night after the restaurants had stopped serving and people were settling down, the city turned off 2 of the wells resulting in a brief pressure drop. The 2 wells were turned back on to restore the pressure hoping that would eliminate the high pressures we were having. We believe we have it under control now with the extremely hard work of our Public Works crew for two full days. It was a combination of an electrical problem on one of the panels, and one of the manual valves was not functioning properly. Mayor Trapani asked the citizens to be patient with the city at this time. The Mayor said he believes they've got the problem corrected and asked the citizens to stay tuned via the City's Facebook page as well as the Website, WLOX and WXXV for more updates.

Re: Easter Parade and Egg Hunt Sunday, April 2, 2023

Alderman Lafontaine moved, seconded by Alderman Richardson to approve holding an Easter Parade/Easter Egg Hunt on Sunday, April 2, 2023, at 12:00 noon. The City is partnering with Hancock County Tourism and will provide Police for the parade route. The route will start by the Waveland Avenue Playground, down Waveland Avenue to the beach, down the beach to Coleman Ave., and up Coleman to the Town Green. The Mayor mentioned that Tourism's idea was a boat parade, and we'll probably follow up with some golf carts or something like that. This event will also include a scavenger hunt for the older kids/teens that will include places all around the City of Waveland.

• Re: Alderman Gamble – With regard to our recent water emergency, she discussed the request to look at getting an Emergency Alert System specific to the City of Waveland. For example, the County uses Code Red, but that does not dissect out the individual municipalities. If we had our own system that could have eliminated some of the frustration last night. Alderman Gamble recommended to the public to use the city website and to check it regularly. They can also sign up for Wavemail via a link on the website by registering for email alerts to be sent directly to the email they registered. Mayor Trapani added that Facebook is also a

good place to check. Alderman Gamble asked if the city has a contact for anyone with the railroad. She mentioned she had a lot of comments with the crossings and not being able to tell them when construction will be complete. She wanted to know if there is anyone we can call to find out this information.

- Re: Alderman Richardson Thanked Chief Prendergast for his officers that were working the night of ALA Ball at the American Legion and the people appreciated them coming out. Alderman Richardson also mentioned the light pole to be installed on Nicholson Avenue. Mayor Trapani told the board that he met with Buddy Borne of Coast Electric and informed them that we know what must be done and believes that there is a pole at the city yard the City can use for this purpose and if there is, then we will ask Coast Electric to install the pole. The city will then have to hire an electrician to run the wire, by running it underground and then up the pole for power.
- Re: Alderman Lafontaine Asked Mayor when he reaches out to CSX to notify them of the upcoming St. Patrick's Parade. A lot of the times they will slow down the traffic coming into that area due to so many people parking alongside the train tracks.
- Re: Alderman Clark Mentioned he had a few complaints from the audience watching on YouTube that said they could not hear what was being said; the microphones not being loud enough on the Live Video streamed on YouTube. He asked that whenever guests approach the podium to speak into the microphone and to also identify themselves so the people viewing on the live steam can hear them more clearly. Alderman Clark also said that when Lamar Advertising put up the digital billboard in Waveland, they made an offer to the city to allow the city to post Boil Water Notices for example, or any events we have going on. Alderman Clark said he reached out to a representative last week and was informed that this offer is still open if the space is available. Other things like PSA's they can run for the city at any time. Alderman Clark said he would get Mayor Trapani all the information to get in touch with them and get a copy for Mrs. Lisa Planchard, City Clerk, as well.
